## NCAA (3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>) Game Recaps

- Texas vs Oregon:** Game 1 of week 3 started with a defensive battle that ended 6-4 at the half. Game tied at 12 after the 3<sup>rd</sup>, making for an exciting final quarter! Oregon improves to 3-0 in a close one 18-14. **Zayden Kennedy** led all scorers with 16 pts.
